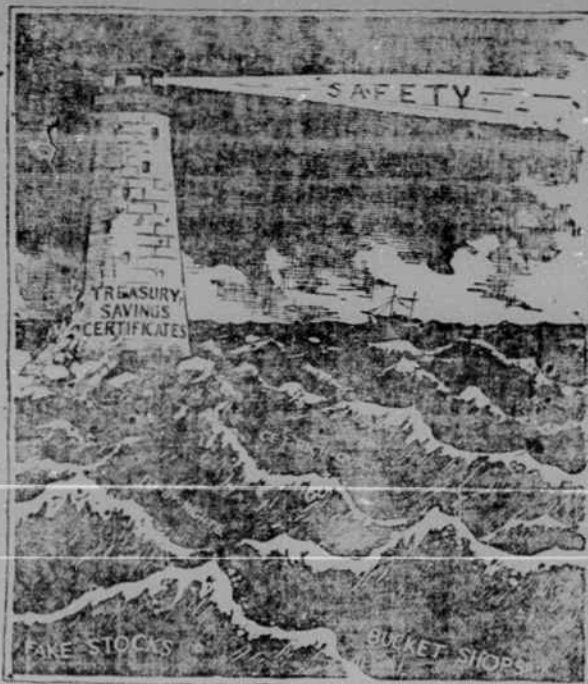
Canoeists Paddling to New Orleans
