Welfare Workers Meet With Andrews Board

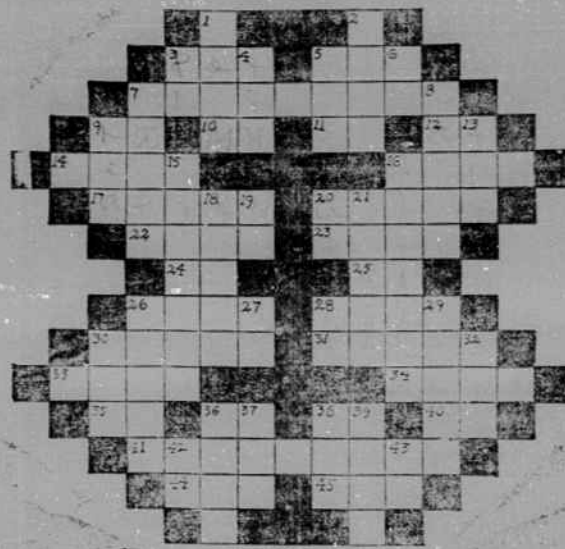
