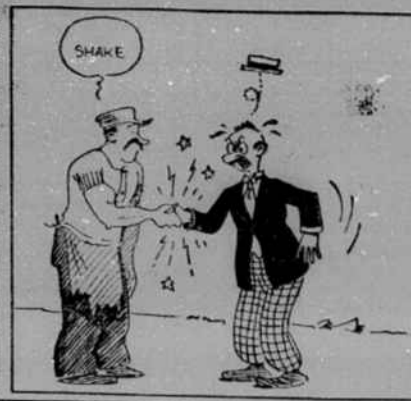

McGIRT BRIDGE OVER CAPE FEAR FORMALLY OPENED

The formal opening of the McGirt Bridge over the Cape Fear River at Elizabethtown marks the completion of the fifth of the large bridges built by the State Highway Commission. The other large structures are the Swift Island Bridge over the Yadkin near Alesandria, the Williamson bridge over the Roanoke at Williamston, the Waxox bridge over the Yadkin at Salisbury, and the Winton bridge over the Chowan at Winton. Two other large structures are nearing completion, the Rocky River bridge, over the river of the same name, near Wadesboro, and the Scotland Neck bridge over the Roanoke near the town of the same name. These structures are permanent in construction and are considered investments by the citizens of the state. In almost every instance these bridge replace toll ferries or toll bridges.
