

Burley Acreage Allotments To Be Reduced

Individual farm acreage allotments of Burley tobacco in Cherokee county for 1946 will be reduced

by 10 percent below 1945 in accordance with a recent announcement by the U. S. Department of Agriculture of a decrease of a similar amount in the 1946 national marketing quota, it was stated today by Victor Raxter chairman of the Cherokee County AAA Committee.
