

Results of experiments in chemical drying of seed grain, using calcium chloride as the drying agent, conducted this last year justify further investigations of this method, according to the USDA.

A gallon of skim milk or buttermilk daily for pigs in dry lot or about 3 quarts for pigs that have access to good pasture is enough to satisfy the protein requirements of pigs that are given all of the corn they will eat.
