Notice To Taxpayers!

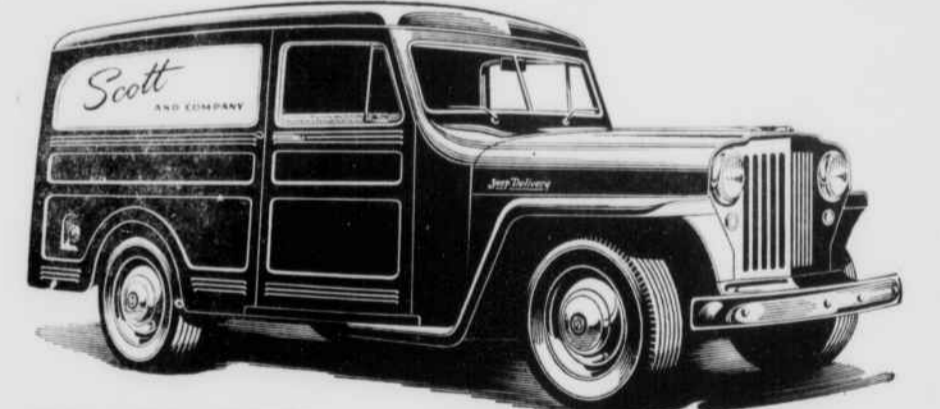
Ed Waldroup, tax lister for Murphy Township, will be at the courthouse in Murphy, N. C., until February 15, to list taxes without any penalty being added.
