Last year there were more than 33,000 youngsters enrolled in 4-H Club work in North Carolina.

A half-pound of nitrate of soda mixed with a bushel of sawdust makes a good mulch for newly set trees and shrubs.

North Carolina poultry feeds will cost 10 to 15 per cent more this year, and labor costs will be higher.

State College specialists say the bee's value as a pollinator is 20 times greater than its value as a honey producer.

DMA records in North Carolina show as production increased from 3,700 to 8,800 pounds, feed costs dropped from \$3.81 to \$2.23 per 100 pounds of milk.

From July to December in 1951, reactors to the official brucellosis tests dropped from 3.1 per cent to 2.6 per cent of the cattle tested.

North Carolina imported nearly 4 million pounds of milk for bottle sales from January through September of last year.
