

### To Provide Relief For Restaurants

...move designed to provide relief for restaurant operators, the OPS has re-established the provision for redetermining ceiling prices, the Charlotte district Office of Price Stabilization has learned.

J. Ray Shute, district director, announced he has received information that the restaurant cut-off

date, previously established as last Aug. 1, has been eliminated, and restaurant operators squeezed by the recent upswing in food costs may apply to recover some of the amount of increased food cost they have been forced previously to absorb.

This authorization is set forth in amendment 6 of Ceiling Price Regulation 134.

### Students Asked To Enter Wildlife Cartoon Contest

The National Wildlife Federation has asked the high school students of America to create a cartoon character which can be used to tell the story of conservation—and offered prizes totaling \$700 in a nationwide contest. Entries must be submitted by next January 31 and winners will be announced during National Wildlife Week in March, 1953.

As in the previous poster contests, the cartoon competition will be divided into junior-high and senior-high groups. Students anywhere in the United States, from the seventh grade through the last year in high school, are eligible.

First prize in the Junior division—grades 7, 8 and 9—is \$100. The second best entry will win \$50; third, \$25; the next ten best, \$10 each. Top winner in the Senior division—grades 10, 11 and 12—will get \$250. Second prize is \$50; third, \$25; next ten, \$10 each.
