No bid of less than \$30.00 per MBM for northern red oak; \$15.00 per MBM for red maple and birch; \$12.00 per MBM for black oak and chestnut oak; \$10.00 per MBM for pitch pine and Virginia pine; and \$2.00 per MBM for hickory, scarlet oak, black gum, hemlock and burch will be considered.
