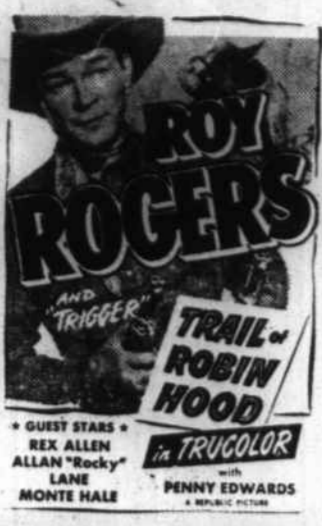


### Folk School Folks

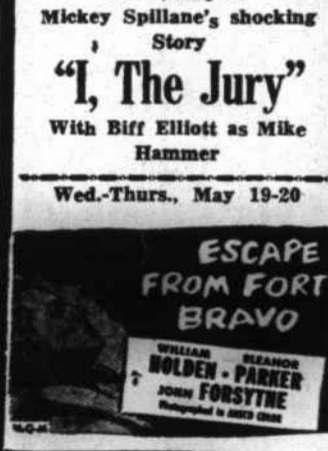

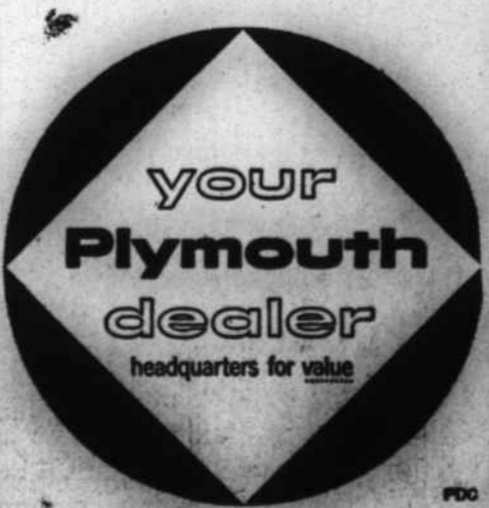

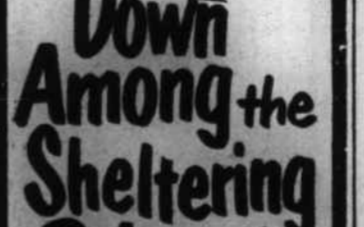
