### FF Declares Dividends

The Directors of the Farmers Federation have declared regular semi-annual dividends on common and preferred stock of the cooperative, payable July 1st to all stockholders of record June 20th, according to an announcement by President James G. K. McClure. Mr. McClure said that this is the forty-second consecutive semi-annual dividend payment by the Farmers Federation.

The dividend on the Federation's common stock is at the rate of 6% while the payment on preferred stock is five per cent.

Mr. McClure reported that sales of the Federation in the twelve month period ending December 31, 1953, totaled \$7,799,015.72, which represented an increase of 12.59% over the preceding year. Payments to Western North Carolina farmers for all types of farm products amounted to more than \$5,000,000 in 1953, Mr. McClure said. The largest increase in the Federation's business was in the marketing of dressed poultry.
