"Unto These Hills" Starts This Week

The colorful, historic Cherokee Indian drama, "Unto These Hills" began its seventh summer-long season in the MountainSide Theatre Tuesday, June 28, at 8:15 p. m. "Unto These Hills" will play nightly except Mondays through Sept. 2.

More than 850,000 persons already have seen the drama which, since 1950, has broken all attendance records for similar outdoor productions.

Alfred Mynders, the eminent editor of The Chattanooga Times, has described it as "the most satisfying and inspiring vacation experience in America."

Produced by the non-profit Cherokee Historical Association, "Unto These Hills" is the re-creation of a forgotten and neglected page of our nation's history.

Descendants of the Cherokee who lived the story are cast in principal roles, and still other Indians are seen in the re-created 18th century Indian village scenes and the dances, including the colorful age-old Eagle Dance.

Rehearsals have been going full swing for the past two weeks under the direction of Harry Davis who has become America's outstanding director in the field of the outdoor drama.

Gatlinburg Drama Now In Production

"Chucky Jack", the new outdoor drama at Gatlinburg, Tenn., opened its first season June 22 and will be produced nightly except Sundays, through Sept. 1.

The drama, written by Dr. Kermit Hunter, author of "Unto These Hills" is being produced as a companion piece to the Cherokee drama.

"Chucky Jack" portrays the colorful career of John Sevier, at one time a great North Carolinian at the time he became a hero of the Colonial forces at the Battle of King's Mountain, and who later became the first and only governor of the Lost State of Franklin, and still later, elected first and

five times re-elected governor of Tennessee.

GARDEN TIME

Each kind of tree, shrub or plant has a best time and method for propagating it. We cannot discuss all of them here but there are a few plants that are most successfully propagated at this season of the year.

For example, many gardeners in eastern North Carolina are growing evergreen species of azaleas. Of course, it is easy to purchase azaleas from nurseries but that will take money and it is not very difficult to grow your own if you are willing to give them some care. These azaleas may be easily propagated by cuttings taken from the plant in June or July. The cuttings should be made of the present season's wood, about four inches long, after the base of the new stem has become partially matured.

The best medium in which to root azaleas is a mixture of half pure sand and half peat moss. This material may be put in a special frame or shallow box to a depth of about six inches, in a place where the frame can be shaded and watered when necessary.

The leaves should be stripped from the lower half of the cutting, the basal end cut with a sharp knife, and dipped in rootone powder. Then cuttings are inserted in the sand and peat mixture about half their length and firmed. They may be set close together in rows. Strict attention must be paid to shading and watering. In a few weeks roots will develop on most of the cuttings and they should be potted up or transplanted to a cold frame where they can be protected until ready to set out in a permanent place. Rootone powder may be obtained at any large seed store.

The peach is another plant that must be propagated at this time of the year. The peach will not come true to variety from seed, and therefore if you have any peach seedlings it is best to graft a known variety upon them. Since the peach cannot be grafted successfully in winter like the apple, it must be budded during July or August. Contact your county agent at once for instructions or bulletins on building peach trees.

Pecans are also budded at this time of year. A pecan does not come true to variety from seed.
