FARMING TIPS

QUESTION: What is the best way to control the relatively new plant pest known as the alfalfa weevil?

ANSWER: Entomologist at North Carolina State College recommend heptachlor as the most effective insecticide in combating the alfalfa weevil. It's safe to use up to two weeks prior to cutting without leaving residue on the hay. It is available for use in sprayers as a 25 per cent emulsifiable concentrate. Recommendations call for the use of one pint of the concentrate in six to 10 gallons of water per acre. The material is also available as a 2½ per cent dust and would then be used at the rate of 10 to 12 pounds per acre.

An unsolved mystery of the sea is the ghost ship Carroll A. Deer A. Deerin, stranded in 1921 on Diamond Shoals, Capeatteras, North Carolina, according to Sinclair's Auto Tour Service. 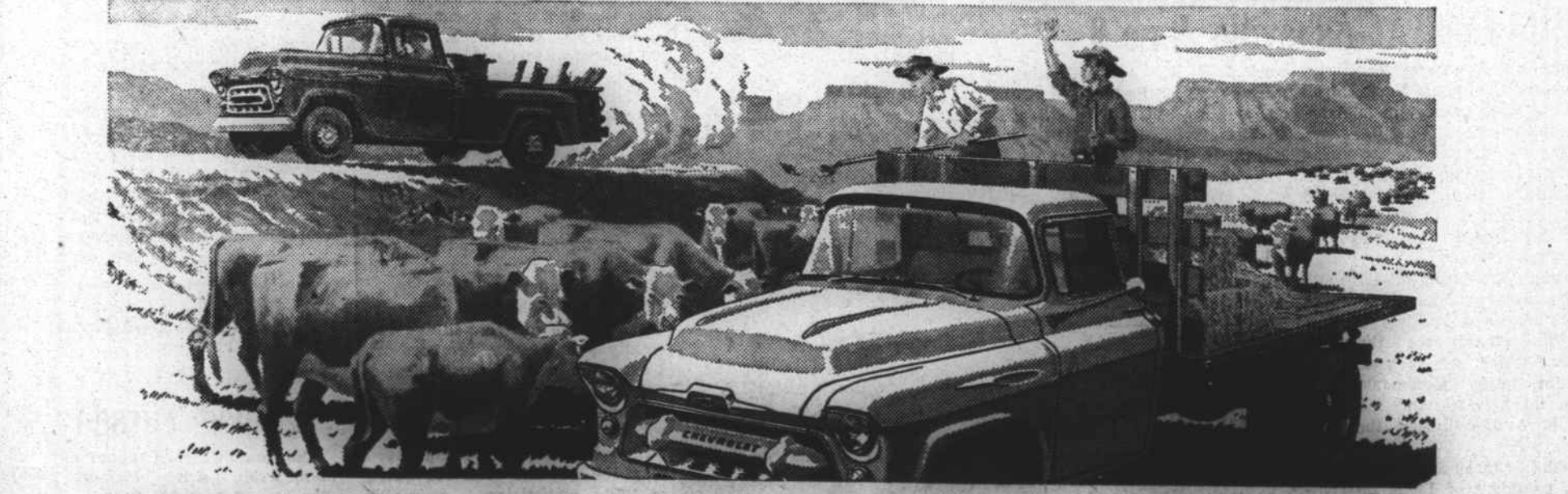
