THE LEADER NEEDED TODAY

And I saw heaven opened and behold a white horse, and he that sat upon him was called Faithful and True. Rev. 19: 11-16.

The prospect is not one to inspire confidence as one looks about the world at the present time. To be sure there are a few things that give encouragement, but these are offset by things that cause uneasiness and apprehension. We look in vain for some commanding personality to lead us out of our perils and problems. We long for the appearing of someone able to speak with persuasive authority to the distracted nations bidding them leave the slippery paths of selfishness and suspicion and walk in the ways of life.

And all the time there is in our midst the Leader we need. Our passage is a wonderful picture of this Leader, drawn by the Christ-

ian Church's first poet. It is a warrior setting out on a crusade against evil and oppression. At the heart of his description of the warrior the poet has introduced a brief reference to those who follow Him. And that we see the picture of the Great Leader Himself. The passage mentions four names which He bears.

The first of these names tells of His faithfulness. He is called "Faithful and True." The early impression made upon man by the Jesus of history, surely originated this name.

We need not fear to put our trust in Him who is called Faithful and True. He sits upon the white horse of Victory. Our trust will not be put to shame, no our loftiest expectations be put to disappointment. Our present problems daunt His spirit.

The second name is a revelation of His mighty power. "And His name is called the Word of God." He is the Word of God, the expression of the mind and will of God. Man was made by God. He is called to live in harmony with Him, so when His will is honored

and obeyed there is peace and prosperity. However when His will is opposed there can be nothing but disaster and death. That the Divine Warrior is the Word of God explains His invincible might and powers. There can be no security without God, and Jesus is His Word.

The third name is a corollary of the second. "And He hath on His garment and on His thigh a name written, King of Kings and Lord of lords." It would mean much to us if we could get the significance of this name. Lordship belongs to the Spirit of Christ upon the Warrior's head are many thorns, signifying his rightful and universal sovereignty.

There is one more name but John can not tell us what it is. "And he hath a name written which no man knoweth but Himself." John apparently means that no name of human invention could adequately set forth the glory of the Warrior's person and power. man-made, as He is beyond the power of man's comprehension. We search in vain for a description that is worthy of Him.

It remains for us to glance at the followers of the Divine Warrior. And the armies which are in heaven followed him upon horses, clothed in fine linen, white and pure.

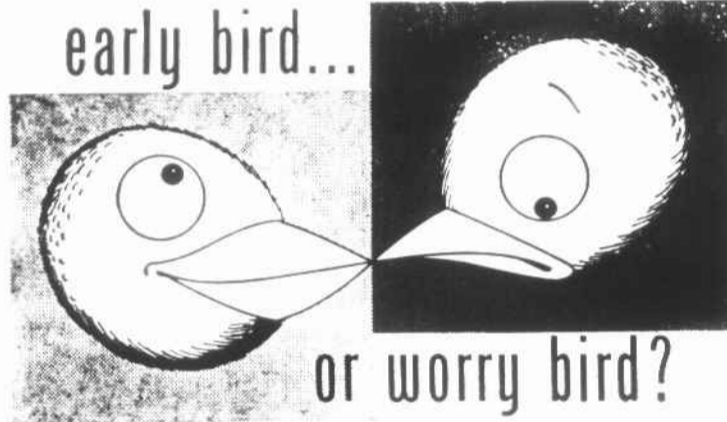
The followers are mounted and dressed in the same manner as our hero, the Leader. Purely as the lovers of heavenly service. The mountains are torrents his purity, he leads a host of ranks.

Equally screaming is the reference to the white horses of the powers. We must not lag behind the Leader. This takes us to the season of surrender to the will of God. If we are to share in the task of helping our world in its present sorry position, we must deny ourselves and take up our crosses. There is no other way. Our great Captain beckons us to conflicts far more thrilling than that of Thermopylae.

Why are we so content to lag so far behind our Lord?
