Public Health Nurses Betsy Brooks and Mary Loy Inman administered tuberculin skin tests. This test is used to determine if a person has been in contact with someone having tuberculosis. When the test results are "read" approximately three days later, positive reactions are followed with an x-ray. At this time further action by a physician may be recommended.
