COUNTY UNDERWRITES ITS OWN 3RD CENTURY PROGRAM

Beginning October 1, 1977, the 3rd Century Artist Program in Robeson County officially passed from the auspices of the state to that of the county. The project will be under the administration of the Robeson County Department of Human Resources, headed by Chris Antwi, and was made possible by the Robeson County Board of Commissions. "I am deeply interested in those projects which are going to benefit Robeson people," said Commissioner Herman Dial during the transaction which was unanimously supported by the Board. Local sponsorship by Robeson County Public Library, Robeson Technical Institute and the State Department of Correction continues.

NEED FOR ARTISTIC EXPOSURE

Robeson County has long been recognized as one of those North Carolina counties in which the need for more artistic exposure is keenly felt. 3rd Century Artists act as resource persons for schools, clubs and other organizations and may be called upon to hold workshops so that the actual creative process may be observed first hand. The services of the CETA-supported artists may be obtained without cost to any other program or fund.
