Notice is hereby given of the intention of the undersigned to file an application with the Local Government Commission, Raleigh, North Carolina, for its approval of the issuance of the following proposed bonds for the Town of Pembroke, North Carolina, which bonds shall be subject to the approval of the voters of said Town at a referendum:

\$550,000 SANITARY SEWER BONDS for the purpose of providing funds, with any other available funds, for enlarging, extending and improving the sanitary sewer system of said Town within and without the corporate limits of said Town, including the expansion, and modification of the existing sewage treatment plant, the modification and replacement of existing sewage pumping stations, the construction and installation of additional sewage collector and interceptor mains and lines, sewage pumping stations and appurtenant facilities and the acquisition of any necessary land, rights of way and equipment therefor.

\$175,000 WATER BONDS for the purpose of providing funds with any other available funds, for enlarging, extending and improving the water system of said Town within and without the corporate limits of said Town, including the drilling of an additional well, the construction and installation of an additional water treatment plant, the modification of the existing water treatment plant and the acquisition of any necessary land, rights of way and equipment therefor.

Any citizen or taxpayer who objects to said bonds in whole or in part may file with the Local Government Commission a statement setting forth his objections and containing his name and address as provided in Section 159-50 of the General Statutes of North Carolina, in which event he shall also file a copy of such statement with the undersigned, at any time within seven days from the date of publication of this Notice. The following positions are available with Robeson County.

A. Water Treatment Plant Supervisor. An individual in this class performs responsible supervisory work in the operation of the county water treatment plant. Work includes operating the water treatment plant on a shift basis, performing laboratory analysis of water samples during shift duty, and maintaining files and records. Independent judgment and initiative are required in the performance of duties. Work is performed in accordance with regulations of the State Board of Health State Division of Water and Air Resources, and the county water treatment and distribution department. Work is coordinated through the Administrative Supervisor and is evaluated by the efficiency of water treatment plant operation and the accuracy of records and reports.

B. Water Distribution Foreman. An individual in this class performs supervisory and skilled tasks in the installation, maintenance, and repair of water pipelines. Work includes installation, maintenance, and repair of the county water pipelines system. Work involves the performance of the more complex tasks in the construction and maintenance of water lines, and supervision of a small crew of laborers on an assigned project, and in assisting with the selection of equipment, materials, and supplies used in the overall work program. Independent judgment and initiative are exercised in the performance of duties. Work is coordinated through the Administrative Supervisor and is evaluated in terms of the quality of Supervision and workmanship and for compliance with instructions and departmental standards.

Minimum Requirements: High school education plus at least three years experience supervising construction and maintenance of water distribution system.
