WASHINGTON, D.C.—Harold Cummings, a CDR in the U.S. Naval Reserves, VR-SI NAS Glenview and a resident of Chicago, Ill. has completed the two-week Defense Strategy Course while on active duty for training at the National Defense University.

The Defense Strategy Course, held annually at the University since 1959, is a professional military education program for senior Reserve and National Guard component officers. The program focuses on the study of national security, the formulation and conduct of national strategy, and the relationships between resource management and policy objectives.

CDR Cummings is one of some 300 senior officers chosen from the National Guard and from the Army, Air Force, Navy and Marine Corps and Coast Guard Reserves to attend the Course this year. Lieutenant General R.G. Gard, Jr., U.S. Army, President of the National Defense University, noted that selection to attend the Defense Strategy Course "represents a special distinction given only to extremely well qualified officers from throughout the United States."

In civilian life CDR Cummings is a pilot with American Airlines, based in Chicago, Ill.
