### SENATOR WILLIAM PROXMIRE TO SPEAK AT PSU FRIDAY NIGHT

When a national legislator as well known as Sen. William Proxmire, democrat from Wisconsin, visits your campus, it is a prestigious event for your University.

On Friday (Jan. 15) at 8 p.m. Sen. Proxmire will speak in the PSU Performing Arts Center. It will be one of the highlights of the PSU Lyceum Series season.

Wisconsin's senior senator, Proxmire earned his undergraduate degree from Yale

University and his Master's Degree in Business Administration from the Harvard Graduate School of Business. He also earned a Master's Degree from Harvard in Public Administration.

A couple of side notes about Sen. Proxmire: A year or so ago, one of the major networks did a special on his jogging enthusiasm. He was then jogging from home to work regularly. He has also received national attention for his hair transplants.

He has a fantastic attendance record in answering

Senate roll call votes. Since April, 1966, he has not missed a roll call--and there have been only 7,000. The average senator misses more than 500, according to reports. The State of Wisconsin is well represented by Proxmire.

Last Labor Day, Jacobs came to the aid of the Town of Pembroke police dispatcher when a man had his wife and the dispatcher at gunpoint
