- CAREER DEVELOPMENT -

The Career Development Program is a six-week course designed to recruit, train and place the unemployed and the underemployed into jobs or vocational training. The curriculum includes job preparation skills in resume and letter writing and interviewing, and basic educational skills in English, mathematics and history. Additional educational experiences are available to students within this program including participation in a video taped WRTC-TV show and fashion display, travelling on field trips to local industries and other developmental locations, and exposure to guest speakers. Registration fee is \$8.00.
