

Union Elementary 4-H Achievers visit Pembroke Rescue Squad

Recently the Union Elementary 4-H Achievers toured the Rescue Squad. The children were chaperoned by

parents and leaders of the 4-H Club. The children were shown the various life-saving apparatus used by the volunteer

rescue unit that is located on Union Chapel Road in Pembroke. A member of the Rescue Squad showed the children the proper way to administer C.P.R. (perhaps better known as mouth-to-mouth resuscitation). The eager Achievers were told different ways they, as private citizens, could be of service to their respective communities. They were told the proper procedures when transporting a victim to a hospital. They were shown how to brace a victim's back if a back injury was suspected. They were also shown what to do if a person is bleeding profusely. In addition to the tour of the rescue facilities, the Pem-

broke Volunteer Fire Department brought over a truck and various fire-fighting equipment and put on an exhibit for the children.

In addition to touring and viewing the rescue squad equipment and fire fighting equipment, the 4-H Achievers were shown a film on safety and precaution.

A spokesman for the Union Elementary 4-H Achievers noted: "The youth of today

are interested in learning how they can be of service to their community. That is why the Union Elementary 4-H Achievers found the tour of the Pembroke Rescue Squad so interesting and exciting. 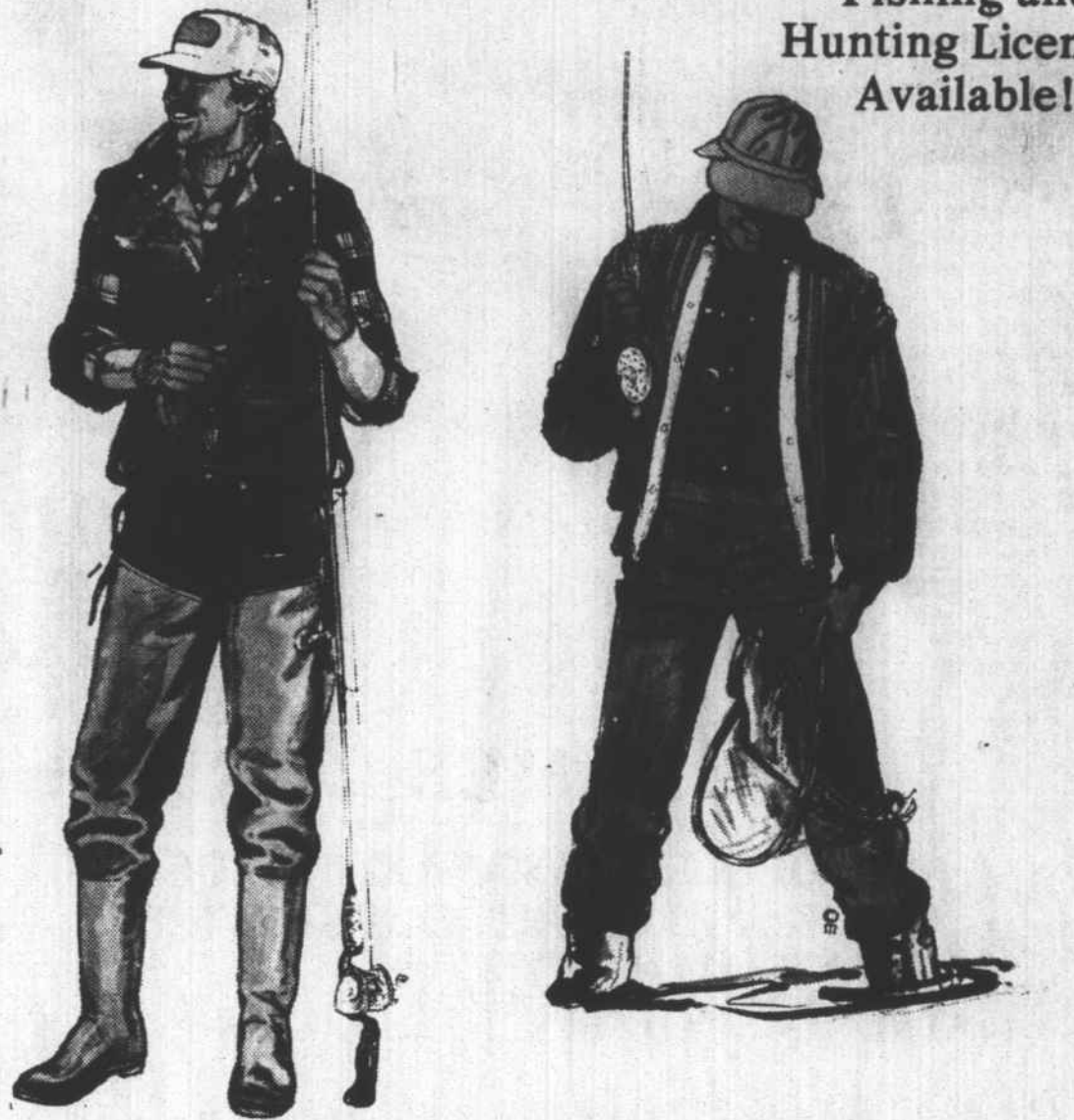
