

LRDA offers help with energy bills

Low income households that need help in paying heating bills may apply for assistance at designated offices and centers of Lumbee Regional Development Association, Inc.

Applications will be taken from October 18 to November 30 for assistance payments through North Carolina's Low Income Energy Assistance Program. Eligible households will receive a check through the mail in Feb. 1984.

Persons who think they are eligible and wish to apply are urged to contact the LRDA office or center near their home.

Food Stamp recipients should bring the following items when they apply: food stamp I.D. card, social security card of head of household.

Non Food Stamp recipients should bring the following kinds of information; social

security card of head of household; verification of all types of income; (wages, social security or SSI, V.A., unemployment, retirement and income from rental property, stocks, bonds, etc); verification of checking or savings account, if applicable.

The LRDA offices and centers taking applications should include: JTPA (Jobs Training Partnership Act, formerly CETA), office at 521-9761; Indian Education Office Annex Building at 521-2401; Thrifty Food Co-op #1, Pembroke at 521-8602; Thrifty Food Co-op #2, Lumberton at 738-7906. All LRDA sponsored day care centers.

Silverhand will attend festival

Internationally known spiritual psychic seer, Ted Silverhand will be at Drowning Creek Reservation, Maxton, N.C. for their Fall Festival.

Silverhand, a Tuscarora Indian known throughout Canada and the east coast of the United States, is recognized as one of "this country's leading psychics alive today."

Silverhand was born with second sight. He began reading at the age of twelve. The sacred ways his gifts were to be used in accordance with tribal tradition were explained to him by his mother, a spiritual reader herself. He reads the same way many of the old Indian seers did; on a spiritual level, which allows him to "see" past, present and future events. He is aided by his Spiritual Guides, an Eagle Feather, Power Stones and Spring Water.

Silverhand prophesies on love, marriage, friends, business affairs, etc. Numbers are given upon request, which has been noted to come within nine days. He reads for many entertainers and a surprising fact is that they often send him gifts of silver after his predictions come to pass. It is not unusual for these celebrities to ask Silverhand to pose with them in a photo.

He has often been called the "psychic's psychic" because of many readings given to other well known psychics. He is the only reader to date, allowed to read at most Native American Affairs, since the passing of famous seer, Mrs. Two Moons which occurred over a decade ago.

"We here at Drowning Creek are happy to have Silverhand here to take part in our Fall Festival which will be Nov. 9th through the 13th," noted a news release. Silverhand will be here on the 11th through the 13th.

This will be Silverhand's only public appearance in North Carolina this year. So plan on coming early. All readings are for fifteen minutes. Money from these readings will be donated to Drowning Creek Reservation.

health hints

Congress and the President have joined with a growing number of concerned Americans who are working to focus national attention on a health problem that can be life-threatening to children under 16. Congress named the week of November 7 through 13, 1983, as National Reye's Syndrome Week.



Reye's syndrome (pronounced it "rye") is recognized by the U.S. Public Health Service as one of the top ten killers among children's diseases.

The U.S. Surgeon General has issued a warning to parents: "Don't immediately give aspirin or any medication containing aspirin to children with chicken pox or flu." Check first with your doctor. The relationship between Reye's and aspirin is suspected, not proven.

Reye's syndrome most often strikes children between five and 16 who are recovering from viral infections, such as flu or chicken pox. This serious condition begins with vomiting and lethargy and may progress to delirium and coma. It is rare, but can be fatal and requires immediate emergency medical attention.
