requires that each day care facility required to be licensed must be under the direction or supervision of a literate person at least 21 years of age. All staff members must be at least 18 years of age or a high school graduate. However, the law does provide that a person less than 18 years of age, but at least 16 years of age, may work in a day care facility as long as that person is under the direct supervision of a regular staff member who is at least the age of 18. In addition to the age

requirements, the General Assembly also provides in its legislation that no person can operate a day care facility or be employed in a day care facility if they have been convicted of a crime involving child neglect, child abuse, or moral turpitude. This provision means that an unsubstantiated charge or rumor about a person being involved in child abuse, child neglect or moral turpitude is not sufficient to keep a person from owning or working in a day care facility; a person must actually be convicted of a crime involving one of these three elements in order to be barred from a day care facility.
