NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING TO CONSIDER AMENDING TOWN OF PEMBROKE ZONING MAP

Notice is hereby given that the Town Council of the Town of Pembroke will hold a public hearing to consider amending the town zoning map such that the below described property is changed from its present classification of Residential Agriculture (R-A) to Multiple Housing (R-M). The property is described as follows:

In Pembroke Township Robeson County, North Carolina West of the Town of Pembroke, on the Southeast side of Pine Street and adjoining bounded on the East by Shirley S. Lowry, on the West by Lot Number 2 and on the Southeast by the Seaboard Coastline Railroad and being more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING at an existing iron stake on the Northwest Seaboard Coastline Railroad, the Eastern corner of the tract of which this is a part (Book 8-N, Page 625); runs thence as the Northwest Seaboard Coastline Railroad South 42 degrees 24 minutes 48 seconds West 214.60 feet to an iron stake on said right-of-way the Southeastern corner of Lot Number 2, thence as the Southeastern Pine Street North of the way North 43 degrees 20 minutes 30 seconds East 214.50 feet to an existing concrete monument on said right-of-way (30 feet from center), Shirley S. Lowry's Western corner, thence as her Southwestern line and the Northeastern line of the tract of which this is a part South 46 degrees 39 minutes 30 seconds East 708.62 feet to the beginning, containing 3.50 acres, more or less, and being Lot Number 1 of the Marvin Lowry Estate according to a survey and map of same prepared by Don Jacobs, RSL and recorded in Map Book 28, Page 27, Robeson County Registry.

NOTICE OF SPECIAL MEETING AND PUBLIC HEARING

The Robeson County Board of Commissioners has called a special meeting for July 17th, at 6:00 o'clock p.m. to conduct a public hearing and otherwise consider appropriation or expenditures pursuant to N.C.G.S. 158-7.1 to encourage the location of a manufacturing enterprise within Robeson County. This action, if taken, will be through the use of the following economic development activities:

1. The acquisition and development of land for an industrial park.

In accordance with N.C.G.S. 158-7.1(d), the County will also consider the option and/or purchase of 50 or more acres of property within the County at a price not to exceed \$240,000.00 and consider the resale of this property to an industry by arriving at the amount of consideration that the County receives after taking into account prospective tax revenues to improvements to be constructed to the property, prospective sale revenues to be generated within the area as well as any other tax revenues or income coming to the County over the next 10 years as a result of the conveyance. The board will determine the probable average hourly wage to be paid to workers by the industry to be located at this property, and fair market value of the interest subject to whatever covenants, conditions and restrictions the Board subjects the property to.

The hearing will be held on Thursday, July 17th, 1997, at 6:00 o'clock p.m. at the Robeson County Administration Building, 701 North Elm Street, Lumberton, North Carolina. The public is encouraged to attend the public hearing.

EXTENSION OF SIGN-UP PERIOD FOR ROBESON COUNTY COUNTY-WIDE WATER SYSTEM, PHASE IV

Construction of Phase IV of the Robeson County county-wide water system began in January, 1997. Residents on roads included in phase IV were offered a sign-up period, including one extension, from January 2, 1997, to April 30, 1997.

The sign-up period has been extended until September 30, 1997, or until the line installed on any given road has been tested and accepted by the county, excluding the following:

Water mains installed on roads previously tested and accepted by the county prior to June 16, 1997. The sign-up fee for these roads will remain at \$300.

Residents may continue to sign up for phase IV of the County Water System at the Robeson County Water Department located at 113 West 8th street, Lumberton, North Carolina (Telephone: 910-671-3478), from 8:30 A.M. until 5:00 P.M. Monday through Friday.
