# The Indian Honor Association of Robeson County Honors These Indian Elders:

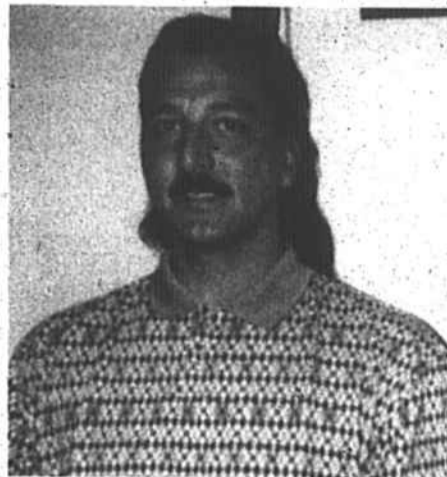
## PURPOSE
