**NOTICE OF SPECIAL MEETING AND PUBLIC HEARING**

The Robeson County Board of Commissioners has called a special meeting for July 17th, at 6:00 o'clock p.m. to conduct a public hearing and otherwise consider appropriation or expenditures pursuant to N.C.G.S. 158-7.1 to encourage the location of a manufacturing enterprise within Robeson County. This action, if taken, will be through the use of the following economic development activities:

1. The acquisition and development of land for an industrial park. In accordance with N.C.G.S. 158-7.1(d), the County will also consider the option and/or purchase of 50 or more acres of property within the County at a price not to exceed \$240,000.00 and consider the resale of this property to an industry by arriving at the amount of consideration that the County receives after taking into account prospective tax revenues to improvements to be constructed to the property, prospective sale revenues to be generated within the area as well as any other tax revenues or income coming to the County over the next 10 years as a result of the conveyance. The board will determine the probable average hourly wage to be paid to workers by the industry to be located at this property, and fair market value of the interest, subject to whatever covenants, conditions and restrictions the Board subjects the property to.

The hearing will be held on Thursday, July 17th, 1997, at 6:00 o'clock p.m. at the Robeson County Administration Building, 701 North Elm Street, Lumberton, North Carolina.

The public is encouraged to attend the public hearing.
