In the matter Of Declaring The Intent Of The Town Of Pembroke To Abandon Or Close College Street From Breece Street To Odom Street

Whereas, there are certain dedicated streets and alleys within the Town of Pembroke that are not necessary for the use and enjoyment of the citizens of this municipality; and

Whereas, the Town possesses the authority to abandon or close such streets and alleys pursuant to G.S. 160A-299.

Now, Therefore, Be It Is Hereby Resolved By The Town Of Pembroke As Follows:

A. That the Town intends to abandon or close part of College Street whose description follows:

That part of College Street running from its intersection with Breece Street to its intersection with Odom Street.

B. That such street and alley are not under the authority or control of the North Carolina Department of Transportation;

C. That a public hearing on the question whether to abandon or close each such street and alley shall be held at 7:00 o'clock, p.m. on the 3rd day of November, 1997, at the Pembroke Town Hall.

D. That a copy hereof shall be published once a week for four successive weeks prior to said hearing in The Carolina Indian Voice, a newspaper of general circulation within this municipality; that a copy hereof shall be sent by certified mail to each owner of property adjoining each such street and alley as shown on the county tax records; and that a notice of the proposed abandonment or closing and the public hearing shall be prominently posted in at least two places along each such street and alley.
