

The Lumbee Tribe/Lumbee Regional Development Association Inc. will conduct an open election on March 30th 2000 to elect two representatives to serve on the LRDA board of directors; districts, precincts and candidates are as follows:

District I: Fairmont, Orrum, Marietta, Sterlings, Thompson- Patricia C. Hunt, Leroy Freeman

District III: Lumberton, Wishart, East Howellsville-James Ertle Chavis, Larry R. Locklear, Rodney Hunt.

District (I) will hold a NEW election because of out-ofdistrict voters that the LRDA board determined were ineligible to vote in the December 2, 1999 Election.
