The Lumbee Tribal Council has established a Vision Quest Award to assist enrolled Lumbee members with vocational and skills training. Applications are available at the Tribal Office at 707 Union Chapel Road in Pembroke or on-line at lumbeetribe.com.

The purpose of the award is to assist tribal members who have lost jobs as a result of plant closings to acquire new job skills that will lead to re-entry into labor force. Vision Quest will provide assistance for tuition, mandatory fees and books.

Applicants must be (1) an enrolled member of the Lumbee Tribe, (2) reside in Hoke. Robeson, or Scotland Counties, (3) be admitted to a program of study at a vocational or post-secondary educational institution and (4) low-income.

Scholarships will be awarded January 1, 2003 for the 2003 spring


