Groundbreaking set for three major UNCP construction projects

PEMBROKE, N.C. - many projects to be funded by \$57 million that UNCP will receive from North Carolina Higher Education Bonds.

- * \$5.7 million Physical Plant Complex

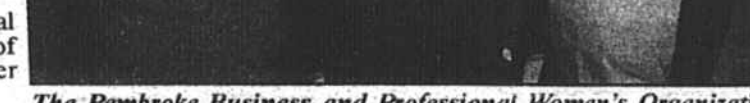
These projects are the first of many projects to be funded by \$57 million that UNCP will receive from North Carolina Higher Education Bonds.

* Oxendine Science Building, which houses the Departments of Mathematics and Computer Science, Biology and Chemistry and Physics, will be completely renovated, inside and out, with a new laboratory wing.

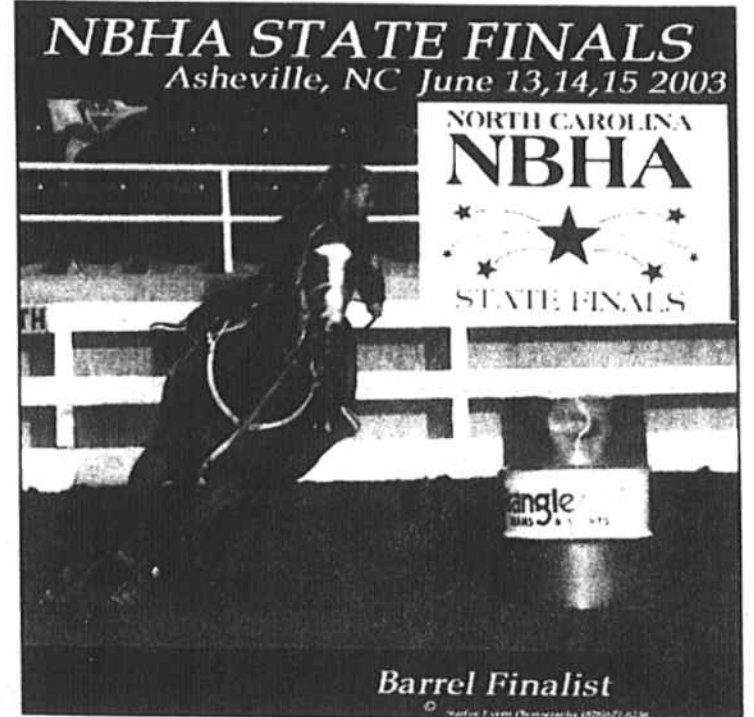
* Jones Health and Physical Education Building will be renovated and new classrooms and offices will be added.

* The new Physical Science Complex is located on the north end of the campus. It will house all maintenance operation, motor pool, Business Services and the offices of Facilities Planning and Construction. The old Physical Plant facilities will be renovated for the new, more spacious Bookstore
