GEORGIA'S FREAK ASSEMBLY GOES INTO HISTOR

Less Real Work and More Welrd Logislation Than in State's History.

FIGHT OVER EVERY BILL HELPED PROTECT PEOPLE

That Many of the Remarkable Bills Introduced Never Saw the Light of Day, Was Due to Strife Rather Than Design, and Still There Was Enough.

Atlanta, Ga., Aug. 11.—The Georgia general assembly adjourned tonight with mixed feelings of regret and pleasure. The legislators regretted that the connal limit of the session had been

reached; the general public rejoiced that the end had come.

This session just terminated will probably do down in history as the one in which less real work for the public was accomplished and more freak legislation threatened than any other in the mamory of the oldest inhabitant. That much of the latter was defeated was due to the disposition the assembly sarry displayed to dispute every bill introduced.

Two of the measures which received the strongest support on the part of the most advanced people never reached a hearing in either house. One was the sampulsory education bill. It provided that each child in the state under the age of fourteen must attend school at least three months a year. This bill was fought strongly by testain influences. There are over 20,000 litterates in the state. The most effective argument used against the bill and the one which probably kept it from getting a hearing, was the 'color line.' The opposents of the bill charged that it would force the negro into the schools, give them a better education than white and make them more useless than ever.

The other measure strongly endorsed was the enero into the assailstitional amendment to the people to decide whether the legislature, instead of meeting cach year should meet only upon each alternate year. This was advocated by business organizations all over the state, but was effectively opposed by the politicians. A resolution favoring a constitutional amendment permitting the popular election of United States senators met a similar fate.
