

STORM OF LIQUIDATION BROKE OVER WALL STREET

Before Close of Session, However, Prices Reacted Sharply.

New York, April 28.—The storm of liquidation which broke over the stock market today was a culmination of influences which have been gathering for some time past. Professional sentiment has been bearish, but operators on this side of the market have been timid because of their fear that the most powerful capitalist groups were opposed to them.

The importance attached to the iron trade as a barometer of general trade conditions made this news influential in increasing the feeling of anxiety over a possible trade recession.
