

WHEAT'S OWN MORE HIGH RECORDS

August Deliveries Goes 8 to 18 Points Above Yesterday's Closing.

New York, May 10.—It was an active day in the cotton market and at times there was some excitement with all the active old crop positions making new high records for the movement and season. The new crop also showed firmness, scoring sharp advances, and while there were reactions in the late trading the close was steady net 4 to 6 points lower on near months, but 8 to 18 points higher on August and later deliveries.
