Resolved by the Board of Commis-sioners of Guilford County that pur-suant to the authority vested in them by virtue of an act of the General Asaembly of North Carolina entitled, "An Act to Provide For the Erection and Maintenance of County Tuberculosis Hospitals" ratified on the 1st day of March, A. D. 1917, and amended on the The day of March, A. D. 1919, and on the 8th day of March, A. D. 1919, and on the 8th day of March, A. D. 1921, a special election in said County is here-by called to be held on the 20th day of December, 1921, for the purpose of submitting to the qualified voters of said County the question of issuing bonds not exceeding \$100,000 in par

bonds not exceeding \$100,000 in par value, the proceeds of same to be used in securing lands and creeting or al-tering building, and equipping same, to be used as a hospital for the treat-ment of tuberculous, and of levying a special annual tax not to exceed five cents on the one hundred dollars (\$100 valuation of property, and fitten cents on the poll, to be used as a mainten-ance fund for said hospital for tuber-culosis.

At which said election those favor-ing the issue of said honds shall vote a ballot labelled with the words "For County Tuberculosis Hospital." and those against the issue of said bonds shall vote a ballot inbelled with the words "Against, County Tuberculosis Hospital"; and those favoring the levy-ing the special annual tax shall vote a ballot labelled with the words "For Maintenance of County Tuberculosis Hospital," and those against levying said tax shall vote a ballot labelled with the words "Against Mapital."
