UNCLE SAM GETS WOMEN A JOB NOW THROUGH BUREAU

Women and Girls Division of Employment Service Is Put In Operation

THE NEW PLAN IS TO BE NO EXPERIMENT

The Greater Need Is Pointed In the Shiness of Women Who Don't Like To Go To Employment Status—Vocational Training Also.

Washington, July 13.—Uncle Sam's all ready to help his woman and girls get jobs.

Organization of the recently created Women's and Girl's division of the United States Employment Service of the Bureau of Immigration now is on a working basis.

Branches of this bureau have been established in all the leading cities of the country.

If a woman in Des Moines wants a job in Kansas City but doesn't know much about conditions down there, she will be told by the bureau.

Each bureau is responsible to the government for the sort of places it sends the women and girls from exploitation and misdirection.

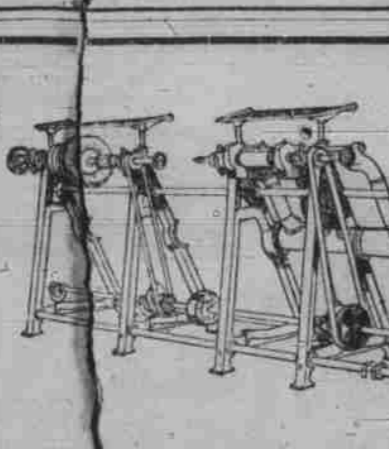
