



GRANTS INCREASE IN PRICE OF COAL

Washington, Oct. 29.—President Wilson Saturday granted an increase of 45 cents a ton in the price of bituminous coal at virtually all mines in the country, effective at 7 o'clock Monday morning. The new prices will absorb wage raises recently agreed upon between operators and miners in the central competitive and other fields.

The president's order provides that the increase shall not apply in case of existing contracts providing for an increase in price to cover any rise in miner's wages. Neither will it apply in districts where miners and operators fail to agree upon a miner's parity which is satisfactory to the fuel administrator.

Millions of dollars of increase cost to consumers is involved in the order which was based upon recommendations made to the President yesterday by Fuel Administrator Garfield. When operators and miners at the Central Competitive Field agreed upon a wage scale last three weeks ago, Doctor Garfield made a careful survey of conditions in the various districts as a basis for his reports to the President.
