

WETS EXPECT AID FROM MISSOURIANS

Sale of 4 Per Cent Beer in St. Louis Signal of Dry Opposition

Washington, March 11.—The sale of 4 per cent beer in St. Louis is regarded by wet leaders here as a signal that Missouri will be the next state to line up in the fight against prohibition.

This will make four states definitely committed to the state's right plan, but each state has the right of prohibition "self determination."

Rhode Island, which has already joined in the United States supreme court attacking the constitutionality of the 18th amendment, leads the wet lineup. Others are New Jersey and Wisconsin. If Missouri joins the fight it will be four states against 26 states, led by

Maine, which have combined to oppose the Rhode Island case.

Wets in Washington attach little importance to the wets' attempt to dry up the prohibition corpse as a political issue in the presidential campaign. That there is little here was shown Thursday when the house overwhelmingly voted against a motion to strike out of the appropriation bill an item for prohibition enforcement.

Wets' hopes center on the Rhode Island suit. Added to this is the action of the New Jersey legislature in legalizing 4 1/2 per cent beer, the federal court decision in Wisconsin favoring the wets and the practically open sale of 4 per cent beer in St. Louis.

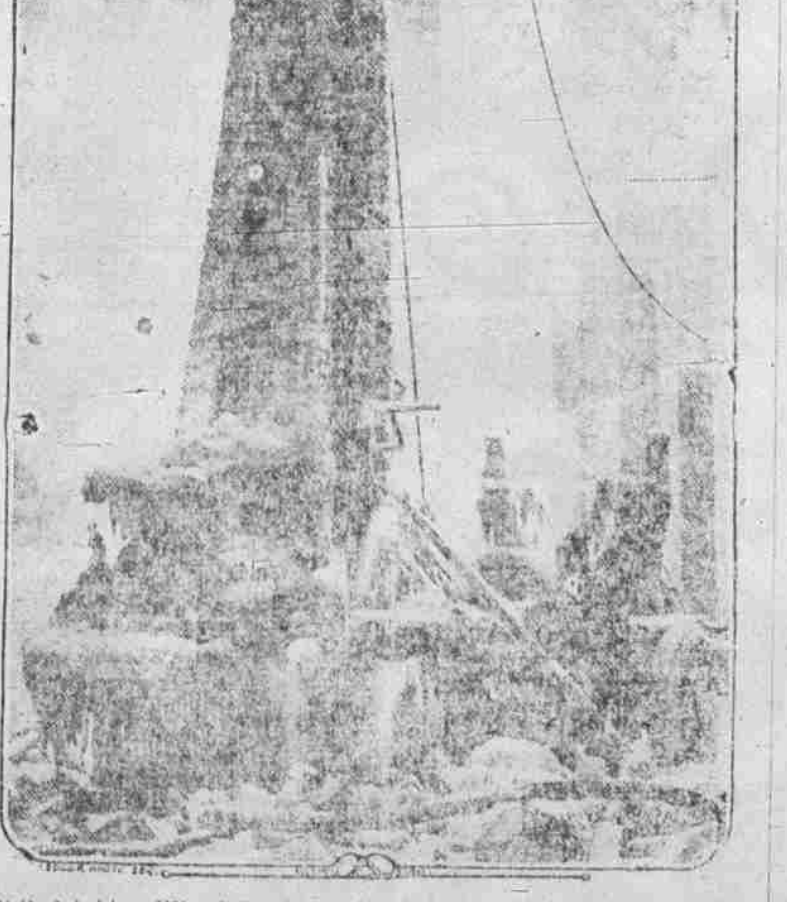
