Boy Scout Movement Revived in Mexico

Mexico City, Aug. 20.—The Boy Scout movement in Mexico is being revived. A call has been issued by the leaders of the movement, for all boys between twelve and seventeen years of age to present themselves for enrollment. The Boy Scouts, or "The Corps of

Scouts," formerly enjoyed a number of Mexican Explorers," as they are called, privileges from the government which provided them with uniforms, money, and even a small money allowance to pay their expenses during their excursions. During the revolution the movement virtually ceased. It is planned to give it new impetus along the lines formerly followed.

WAR STOCKS CAUSE FRANCE DIFFICULTY

Stock Sold Ukraine by America and Taken Back Source of Trouble

Paris, Aug. 17.—A pile lot of American war stocks sold to a Ukrainian cooperative society last spring for \$5,000,000 and later taken back by the American authorities, has caused the French war department almost as much trouble as the liquidation of the remains of the stocks.

One part of the stocks was warehoused at Lunger, France, where the French courts have insisted to determine their actual ownership. Another part is warehoused at Marseilles in the name of the Ukrainian society and cannot be touched by the American authorities although up to this time no disposal or departure of the stocks has been prevented.

The larger part of the stocks were housed at Bordeaux, was ransacked by the Ukrainians for choice bits and later by thieves but the remainder has just been removed by the American authorities and sold to the Jugoslav and Czechoslovakian governments. The only bit that managed to sail with a cargo of the stocks was turned back in May by an American destroyer after it had left Constantinople and the cargo was later disposed of there, little money remaining after the freight charges had been repaid to the Ukrainians.

The stocks, consisting largely of clothing and medicines, were sold on the understanding that they would be used for the commission which was then in France accepted in payment unless guaranteed by the Ukrainian government of that period. Some months afterward it was discovered that the agents of the cooperative society were peddling the stocks about France and the commission decided to take them over.

Mexico Tries To Keep Her Workers At Home

Mexico City, Aug. 19.—Governmental efforts to stay the emigration of Mexican workers into the United States and to induce those already there to return to their native land have taken form in the official support given a corporation recently formed to develop 500,000 acres of land in the Puerto Valley of Sinaloa. The company, in addition to a federal concession, has been granted a subsidy of \$2,500,000 by the state government of Sinaloa and large tracts of land in that state. It plans to construct several reservoirs at Choix and a dam at San Blas, with canals on each side of the Puerto river to be used for irrigation purposes. With land available for irrigation it is hoped to keep Mexican laborers in Mexico and secure the return of thousands who have emigrated to the United States.

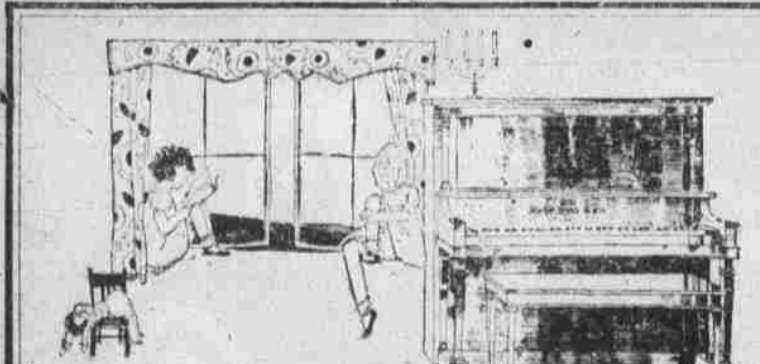
