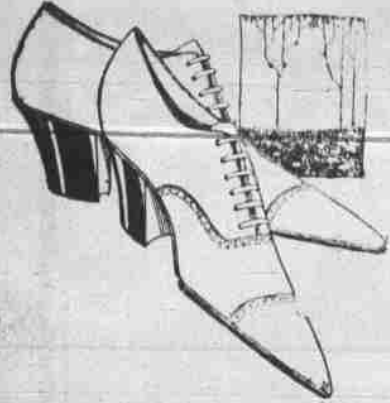

**NARRAGANSETT BAY TO BE** BASE FOR DESTROYER FLEET  
Newport, R. I., April 29.—Narragansett Bay is to be the base of the destroyer squadron of the Atlantic fleet this summer. The rendezvous will bring 150 destroyers and auxiliary vessels to those waters. Five destroyers have already arrived.

The main fleet of destroyers, it has just been announced, will leave Charleston, S. C., their winter base, on May 15, and proceed to New York for a stay of two weeks to permit the crews to have short liberty. The squadron under command of Rear Admiral A. H. Robertson, will then proceed to Narragansett Bay arriving about June 5.
