Historic Relics Are Stolen From Museum

Madrid, May 9.—The recent theft from the Royal Armory of the two golden votive crowns of the Visigothic King Swintila deprived Spain of one of her greatest treasures, since only in the Cluny museum of Paris do similar specimens exist.

Historians suppose that the two crowns originally were part of the treasure of the old cathedral of Toledo before the present building was constructed. It is believed they were removed from the church when the Arab invasion occurred and buried in a sepulchre in the hamlet of Guarraxar, in the vicinity of Toledo, where they were discovered after six centuries.
