## LAND BANK NOW READY TO LEND

W. T. Old and W. G. Gaither Identified With New Norfolk Institution

The Virginia-Carolina Land Bank of Norfolk, Va., capitalized at \$250,000, is now ready for business, having been chartered by the Federal Farm Loan Board under an Act approved June 17, 1919. W. T. Old, formerly of Elizabeth City, who for some years has been prominent in Norfolk financial circles is vice-president of the new institution, and W. G. Gaither, first vice-president of the First & Citizens National Bank of this city, is a member of the board of directors.

Under the provisions of the Farm Loan Act, the new bank is authorized to make loans and advance money for the following purposes: (a) To loan on first mortgage on farm lands within the Land Bank District, which in this case comprises Virginia and North Carolina; and which mortgages may subsequently be used as collateral for issues of Federal Farm Loan bonds to this bank; and that money may be loaned for the following purposes: (b) To purchase land for agricultoral use. (c) To purchase equipment, fertili-

zer, live stock, etc., for the operation of the mortgaged farm. (d) To provide buildings, drainage, and other permanent improvements on

the mortgaged lands. (e) To pay off existing debts, and




