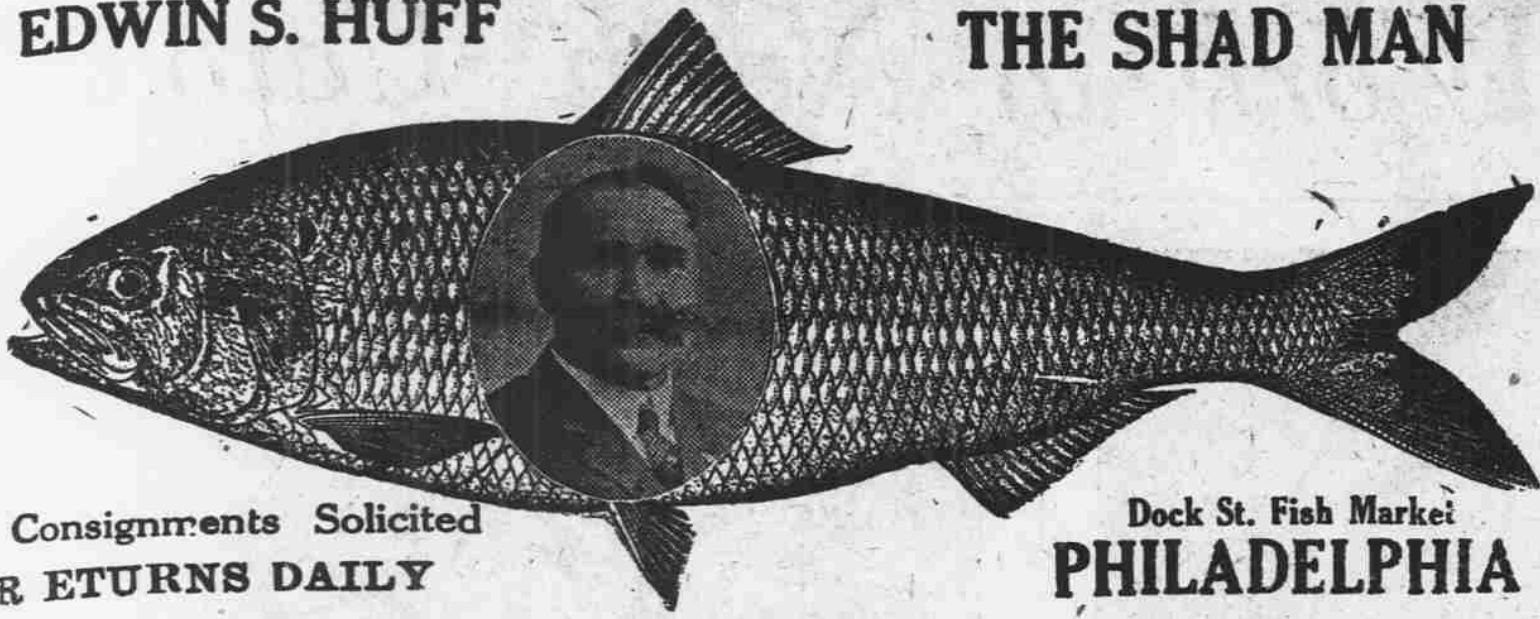

NOTICE OF ELECTION.
Under and by virtue of a Private Act of the General Assembly of North Carolina, session of 1921, entitled an "Act to Authorize the Elizabeth City Graded School District to Issue Bonds and Levy Special Tax," and pursuant to proper application made to the Board of Aldermen of Elizabeth City, by the Board of Trustees of said Graded School, as provided in said Act, and pursuant to a motion unanimously carried before the said Board of Aldermen, in regular session assembled on this the 9th day of March, 1921, and a quorum being present and voting, an election is hereby called to be held on Friday, April 8th, 1921, when the duly qualified voters of the Elizabeth City Graded School District, will determine the issuance, by the trustees of the Elizabeth City Graded School District, of School Bonds, aggregating not to exceed Four Hundred Thousand (\$400,000.00) Dollars, and the purpose of said bonds being as follows:
FIRST: "In paying off and discharging the present floating indebtedness of said Graded School District, including debts evidenced by notes, secured or unsecured, and all other indebtedness of said Graded School District, except the original bonded indebtedness thereof."
SECOND: "In purchasing lots or grounds for school purposes, and for constructing, repairing, equipping, heating and furnishing such graded school building, or buildings, within the said Graded School District, as the said Board of Trustees may deem necessary and adequate to meet the present and future needs of the school population of said Graded School District."
The boundaries of the said Elizabeth City Graded School District include all that territory within Elizabeth City Township, together with that portion of Providence Township lying North of the Norfolk and Southern Railroad, and the main line track of the Norfolk and Southern Railroad, to determine whether an annual and special tax shall be levied for the purpose aforesaid and which annual and special tax shall be assessed and to create a sinking fund for the payment of the principal of said bonds; and said bonds shall be in a sum not to exceed Four Hundred Thousand (\$400,000.00) Dollars, and payable from five (5) to forty (40) years, after date of issue.
The ballots shall be white in color and of a size one and one-half inches by three inches. At said election those who are in favor of the issue of said bonds shall vote a written, or printed, or partly written, or partly printed ballot, bearing the words, "For School Bonds," and those who are opposed thereto, shall vote a written, or printed, or partly written, or partly printed ballot, bearing the words, "Against School Bonds."
The said election shall be held on Friday, April 8th, 1921, as aforesaid, and the polls will be open from sunrise to sunset on the day of the election.
The several polling places, together with the judges of election and the registrars shall be as follows:
FIRST WARD: polling place, H. G. Godfrey's store; registrar, H. G. Godfrey; judges of election, L. R. Foreman and Mrs. A. B. House.
SECOND WARD: polling place, the store on Harvey Street immediately in the rear of Henry William's store; the registrar, Charles Williams; judges of election, E. M. Stevens and Mrs. Mary Tryphond.
THIRD WARD: polling place, Whitehurst's store on Feasting Street; registrar, W. M. Hinton; judges of election, Miss Marcie Albertson and John H. Wells.
FOURTH WARD: polling place, City Market; registrar, N. A. Jones; judges, G. A. Twiddy and Mrs. Bessie Stuart.
Notice is further given that a new registration of all qualified voters within the said Elizabeth City Graded School District is required and that the said registrars will keep the registration books open for the registration of all qualified voters, between the hours of 9:00 o'clock A. M., and 5 o'clock P. M., beginning on Saturday, March 13th, 1921, and keeping such books open until Saturday, March 20th, 1921; notice is further given that on Saturday, March 13th, 1921, and on Saturday, March 20th, 1921, the registration books will be kept open until 8:00 o'clock P. M. for the registration of all qualified voters within the said Elizabeth City Graded School District.
