The Financial System Embodied in the Tax and Funding Acts.

The incidents of the new issue of treasury notes are as follows, viz: 1. They are payable two years after issue, and receivable for all public dues (except export and import duties).

Income tax for 1864 now due. From income of side money, rent, servant hire, interest on notes, value of cattle and beef, and any other source derived from taxed property.

Salary for 1864. Give in and pay extra profit tax levied by late act, for 1864. Corporation tax on excess of profits are 25 per cent. Corporations pay no other income tax for 1864.
