GOVERNOR'S MESSAGE.
EXECUTIVE OFFICE, N. C. RALEIGH, 17th Nov. 1816.
To the Honorable the General Assembly of the State of North-Carolina...

However, when we reflect on the lethargy which has pervaded our state and enervated her energies until a few months past...

I shall therefore in a plain, brief, and, I trust a candid manner, unfold to you my views of state policy, so far as I believe them to be connected with an intelligent and correct discharge of your legislative functions...

The present organization and debased condition of the Judiciary Department, is entitled to, and I have no doubt will receive, the marked attention of the Legislature...

Where, however, power is bestowed, there is a correspondent accountability; therefore, although the Legislature can, consistently with their delegated powers...

When the present salaries were fixed, what were the duties of the Judges? Not half as burthensome, I will venture to say as at this day. Session after session have duties been prescribed...

There are various ways by which their burthens may be lightened, and justice more correctly administered. I will take the liberty of recommending that three additional Judges be appointed to preside in our Supreme Court...
