MEMORIAL.

A proposed Memorial to the Congress of the United States.

The following proposed Memorial is respectfully submitted to the consideration of the members of the United States, with a desire that its object may receive that share of attention which its importance demands...

To the Honorable Senate and House of Representatives of the United States in Congress Assembled:—

The Memorial of the undersigned citizens of the United States respectfully represents, that while they have rejoiced in the privileges of a free people, they have been deeply affected with the multiplied instances of criminal prosecutions, imprisonments, capital convictions, and public executions, which have recently occurred in several states.

In the course of the late war between Great Britain and the United States, many thousands of people were licensed by the two governments to commit just such acts of injustice, depredation and violence, as those for which pirates are hanged in time of peace.

It is impossible for your memorialists to conceive how such deeds of rapine and violence can be reconciled to the principles of justice & humanity, when done by privateersmen, any more than when done by unauthorized pirates.

As in the business of privateering all the odious passions of human nature are licensed—as the youth of our country become associated with desperate and unprincipled men, let loose from every moral restraint; what better can reasonably be expected, than that many of them will, after the close of a war, follow the trade to which they had been educated?
