that is ideal for creative research  
and experimental work.

In the proposed initial unit  
will be housed: two laboratories,  
a museum, storage room, two  
work-rooms, a seminar room and  
three offices; also a green-house  
will be attached to the first build-  
ing unit. Estimated costs for  
the first building: construction  
of building, \$15,000; green-  
houses, \$800; equipment, \$3,000  
and annual budget allowance,  
\$5,000—a total of \$23,800.

Because of the great expense  
entailed in research work, it is  
important that the work must not  
suffer from the lack of sufficient  
funds to carry on the labora-  
tory program. For this reason it  
is believed the Laboratories  
should be endowed or should be  
the recipient of a grant that will  
be increased as the expansion  
program progresses.

Contemplated units for the  
completed Carver Creative  
Research Laboratories are as fol-  
lows: In the field of Sciences,  
Agronomy, Bacteriology, Et-  
hology, Botany, Creative Chem-  
istry, Mycology and Plant Gen-  
etics; in the field of Art—Cera-  
mics.

2 squares unsweetened chocolate
