

NATIONAL BAPTISTS CONVENE IN ALA.

Representatives From 32 States in Attendance

Birmingham, Ala., Municipal Auditorium, Sept. 8—(Special) With the spiritual and religious theme "GO—Teach All Nations," as adopted by the World's Association, the National Baptist Convention of America opened here in the Municipal Aud. at 9 o'clock central standard time today. The devotional period was led by the Rev. O. E. Kelly, D. D., of Newark, N. J., and Rep. J. S. Givens, D. D., of New York, conducted the devotion while the vast audience coming from thirty-two different states was assembling, seating themselves by states. The Devotion Theme for the morning was "Missions." It was discussed by the Rev. A. Hubbard, D.D., of Chicago.

The Woman's Auxiliary is also in session, with Mrs. M. Fuller as president, Mrs. E. White as corresponding secretary. The also a Junior Convention headed by Mrs. Hattie Williams as president and Miss Mora Dee Dailey as corresponding secretary. The women have as their theme for the entire meet, "For We Are Laborers Together With God." These religious forces represented the parent body and the two auxiliaries will devote the entire five days in spiritual awakening, backed up by the solidarity of a denominational organization in the interest of the cause of Christ and its kingdom, plus the enlargement on the New Testament Church idea. The three point program adopted in the early part of the year and recommended by Rev. Prince, the president, will be strictly adhered to. Foreign missions, home missions and education will not be overlooked.

The introductory sermon today was preached by the Rev. J. P. Reeder, D. D., of Columbia, S. C., who was the entertaining pastor last year. He had as an

alternate the Rev. M. Peace of the South Carolina capital. During the first period of the morning only the religious fervor and spiritual awakening were noticeable in the vast audience in the auditorium and in the crowded Sixteenth Street Baptist Church where the other two auxiliaries were in session.

At two-thirty today the convention re-assembled, after having been in recess for one hour, opening with a song service conducted by the Rev. I. Golphin of Tennessee. The first of the boards to make its report was the Home Mission Board, with the Rev. Smith, of Chicago presiding as chairman, and Rev. I. M. Hendon, of Chicago, the corresponding secretary, reporting for the board.

The convention adjourned at 5 o'clock, but re-assembled at 7 for song service and for the local program which provided for welcomes from His Excellency, the Governor, His Honor, the Mayor, and from various denominations. The convention will address itself to an educational rally to assist Va. Theological Seminary at Lynchburg, Va., Guadalupe College at Seguin, Texas, and the Florida Baptist College at St. Augustine, Fla., not overlooking the other phases of the work in the development of the quarter section of land which was donated for the building of a home for aged men and women and an orphanage for children. KNOXVILLE, Tenn., Sept. 9—(By O. B. Taylor for ANP)—Under the auspices of the Tenn. State Medical Ass'n (white) a course in Obstetrics and Gynecology is being conducted at the General hospital here.

All the colored physicians of Knoxville, who are equally qualified, have been asked to attend the lectures and clinics, which will extend over a period of 10 weeks: Of the more than 100 physicians present at the first lecture and clinic held Thursday night, four were Negro and two more, making six, will be added to the list.

TRIANGULAR BEAUTY ASSOCIATION TO RAISE STANDARDS IN CHICAGO

CHICAGO, Sept. 9—(ANP)—In order to rid the profession of cutthroat competition and at the same time standardize prices and working conditions to meet state laws, Chicago's leading beauticians met Sunday, at the Wm. C. J. Walker College of Beauty Culture to reorganize the the Beauticians' Triangular association composed of schools, shop owners and operators.

The association has the backing of the organizations of Master Barbers and Journeymen Barbers who have waged a similar campaign in their field. Mrs. Marjorie Stewart Joyner is president of the Beauticians' association, with Mrs. Dimples Patterson, treasurer, and Mrs. Viola Walton, secretary. They represent respectively beauty schools, operators, shop owners.

It was pointed out at the meeting that under existing conditions neither shop owners nor operators are making a decent living and often end the week with less money than women employed in the commonest kind of unskilled work. This condition, those assembled were told, exists in large city except Chicago.

The organization will begin an immediate drive to rid the profession of unlicensed operators, (house shops) unsanitary working conditions and to lift cut prices and shorten hours to dollars richer since he started as an independent lottery operator.
