Charlotte Housing Durham Socials Project To Open July 15

CHARLOTTE—Ten of the thirty-eight of Fairview Homes, Charlotte's low cost housing project for Negroes will be opened July 15, according to J. Frank Hanley, manager of the project, who has recently returned to city from Jacksonville, Florida, where he went for observation and study.

Practically all of the buildings are under construction, and it is necessary to drive or walk through the entire project to fully realize its magnitude. The project fronts on Oaklawn Avenue, but extends far off the street. It has been named "Fairview Homes." Four hundred and fifty families will make their homes here when the project has been completed. Forty two acres of land are used for the project.

The buildings alone will cost nearly nine hundred thousand dollars, and one hundred and fourteen dollars will go for plumbing, forty four thousand dollars for site improvement and sixteen thousand dollars for landscaping. The total amount of contracts is \$1,015,061.

One important feature of the program is that the City of Charlotte, under its agreement with the government, will eliminate one substandard dwelling, by demolition, closing, or repair by compulsion, for each unit in project. This applies to the white project as well.

In addition to the 462 living units, an administration and recreation building will be provided. The buildings are to be two story and one story flat roof types, and will cover only slightly more than 10 percent of total area of the project, giving plenty of room for outdoor recreation, ventilation, etc.

Included in the cost of rent will be kitchen ranges, with facilities for hot water, combination sink and laundry tubs, medicine cabinet and complete bathroom facilities.

What this will mean to the community as a whole is incalculable, but it is believed that the project will not only eliminate some of the city's worse eyesores, but will, by example, help to bring forth a cleaning out of the slums by showing that low rents can profitably be charged for decent living quarters.

That this sort of program is vitally important in Charlotte is evidenced by the fact that among the substandard dwelling units: 6,116 are in need of major repairs or unfit for use; 5,044 have no indoor flush toilets;

Hold Confab

WASHINGTON—The Sixth Annual Conference of Veterans' Placement Representatives of the Bureau of Employment Security Social Security Board met at the Lee Sheraton Hotel from May 6 to 9. Among the speakers who addressed the Conference were the following officials: General James A. Drain, assistant to the administrator of the Federal Security Agency; Chairman of the Social Security Board Arthur J. Altmeyer; General Frank T. Hines, administrator of the Veterans' Administration, and Lieut. Lawrence A. Oxley of the Social Security Board. Over a hundred veterans' placement representatives for each state and territories were in attendance and participated in a training program to stimulate increased placement of World War veterans. The employment problems of the handicapped veteran, counseling and placement service for sons and daughters of veterans, and the employment problems of the Negro were major program topics.

Speaking to the conference, Lieut. Oxley indicated the difficulties faced by the Negroes in their search for adequate job satisfaction. The speaker outlined the objectives of the Bureau of Employment Security in the field of Negro placement activities and outline in detail the outcomes of twelve officially sponsored state conferences on placement problems.


