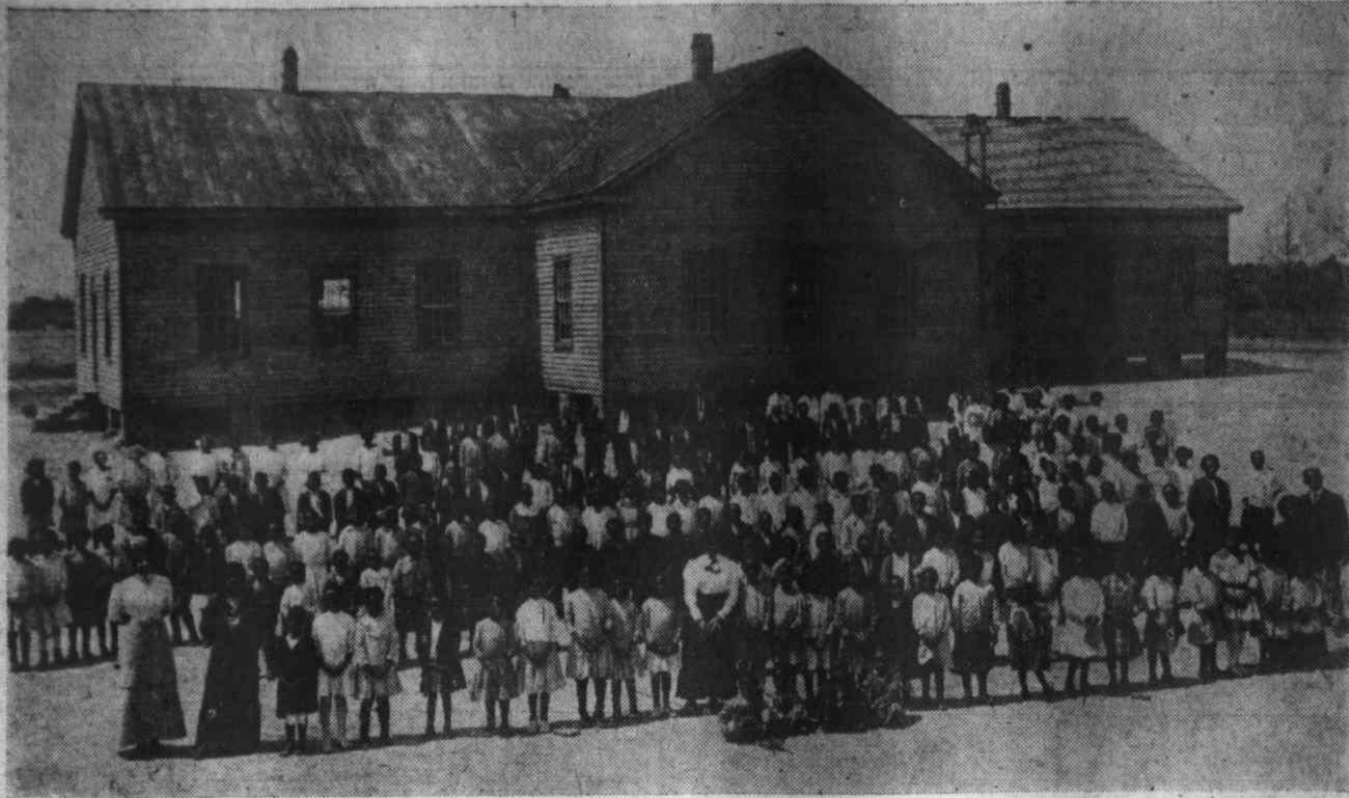


Greenville Public School 1903



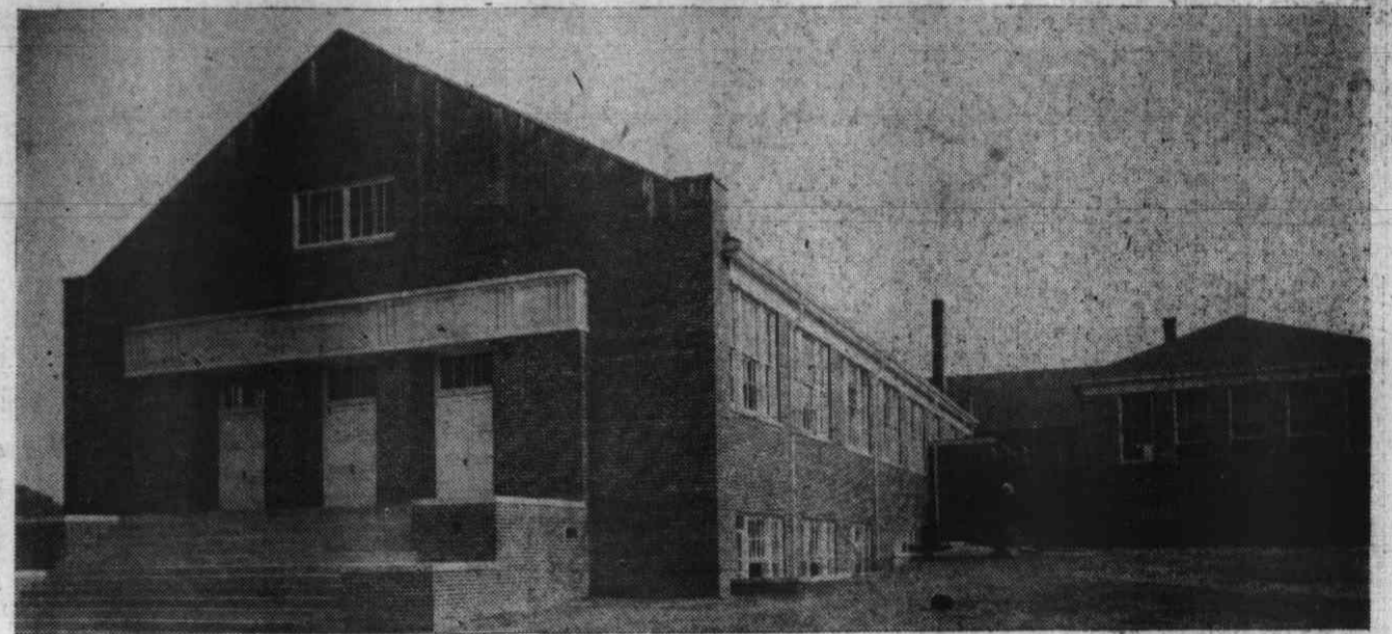

Fleming Street Elementary School, Greenville



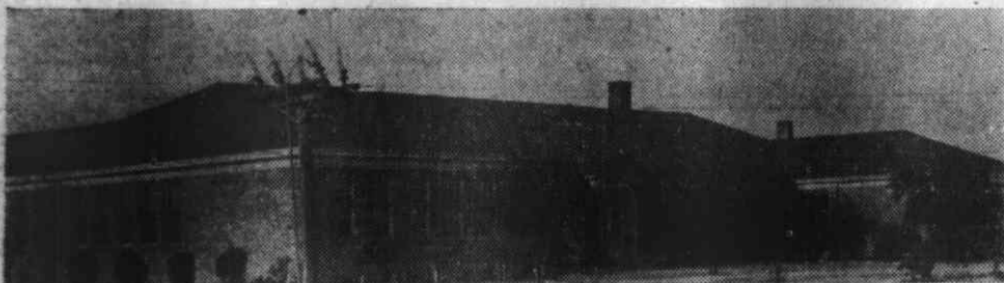

The building up until the present was used as a combination high and elementary school building, but with the erection of the new Industrial High School and Gymnasium building, this plant will henceforth be used to house elementary students only.

Greenville's Modern Gymnasium



Pictured above is the new gymnasium, which is a part of the rapidly expanding plant of the Industrial High School of Greenville. The gymnasium has facilities for all indoor sports and activities, and a seating capacity of 500. This is one of the few gymnasiums found in Negro High Schools in the State of North Carolina.

New Industrial High School, Greenville



Pictured above is the recently completed industrial High School building in Greenville. The building is of the latest design in school architecture, having a large auditorium, and all adequate facilities for the furtherance of Principal Eppes program of industrial education.
