Raleigh - From Januaruy 1st, through May, this year, there were 34,444 babies born in North Carolina, which was just 1,973 in excess of the number born during the corresponding period of 1940, the State Board of Health

Futhermore, births during that period exceeded the 14,424 deaths n the State by 20,020.

Maternal deaths were shown to be on the decrease, there having been only 161 during the first five months of 1941, as compared with 188 for the same period last year, a decrease of 27.

But the mounting toll of deaths from preventable accidents also omes in for consideration.
